We will also continue to maintain some priority and exposure for beloved compositions, arrangements and texts by talented Byzantine Ruthenian clergy and laity, all of which is part of our particular Church's prayer life and identity among Eastern Christians. Group singing is a way of using God-given talents as part of a harmonious team to bring praise and thanks to God for all that was given to us and the world, to bring joy to the world for the same reasons, and to show the beauty of God's creation that can be accomplished when people work together as a group.

Hope to see everyone at rehearsal. In the rehearsals the choir is seated, and there is a short break in the middle of the rehearsal. New members of all ages and abilities are welcome, including students of middle school/high school/college age. One does not need to know how to read printed musical notes in order to join the group.
